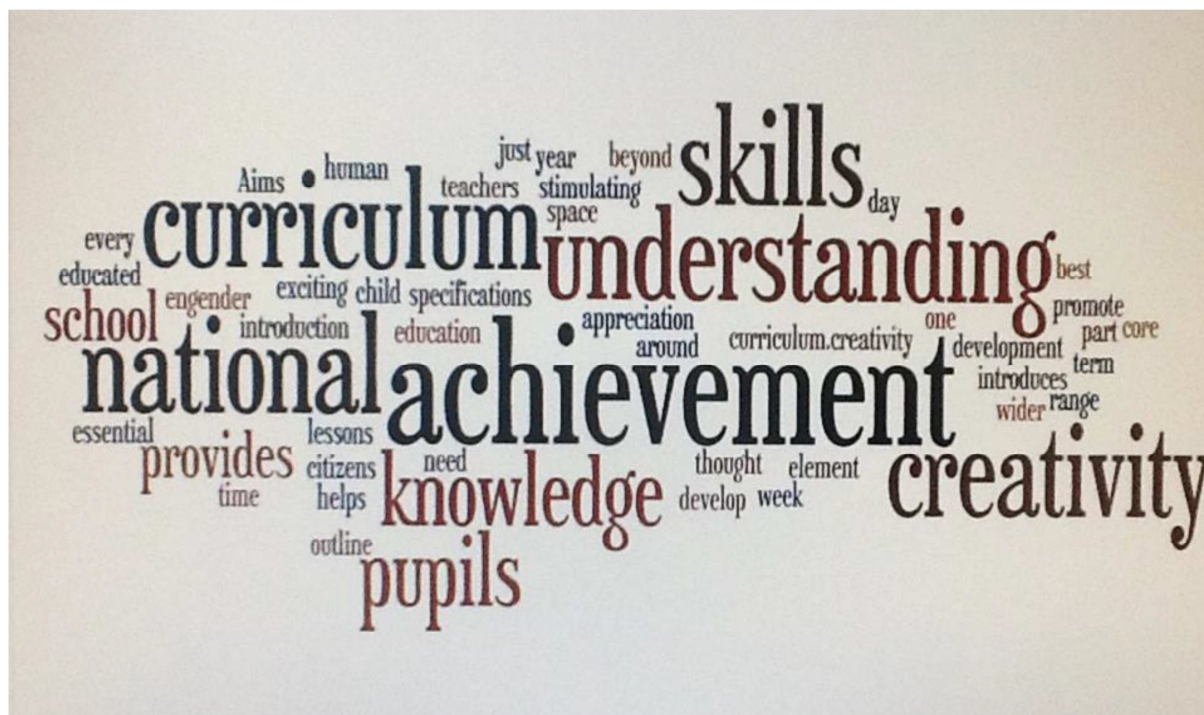


Navigating the Changing Educational Landscape – the National Curriculum and the Arts
